Camping opens at 12 noon on Friday, October 16. Ground fires are allowed pits must be filled no wood chunks left behind . Skirmishers are asked to bring their own water and take trash home for disposal. The dumpster on site is reserved for broken targets and other range waste.

Maybee Sportsman's club will be providing the food service for the weekend. Saturday and Sunday Breakfast and lunch. Steak dinner on Saturday night and bar are available.

All N-SSA rules will be in effect throughout the weekend. Individual events will be classified per NWT classifications, with places paid accordingly.

We will be using a 5 person team format for the Musket, Carbine and 3 person for smoothbore match, you must have 3 unit members to constitute a legal team for Musket and Carbine and 2 for Smoothbore.

Covid19 protocols will be in place.

This is a volunteer skirmish all members must help with setup, tear down, and if you're not shooting act as a safety officer. The range will be set up and targeting will be made. You don't need to show up early just help out.

In an effort to be more “earth friendly” and to reduce costs; please return unhit targets to the ready area. Also, there will be marked containers to recycle the yellow pigeon ties. Please help the region with this effort.
