

NWT FIREARMS INSPECTION CERTIFICATE

The designated member of your unit is charged with the responsibility of inspecting the firearms that the members of the unit will be using for competition for the next skirmish year.

This person should review the following sections of the skirmish rules before making inspections:

- Section 4 Firearms, equipment, and ammunition, especially article 4.13 dealing with welded breeches.
- Article 9.9.1 and 9.11 dealing with checking full and half cock pulls.
- Check sights for correct configuration and location.
- Check for proper ramrods and triggers.
- Check the condition of the stock.
- If the firearm is not an approved production firearm, has it been individually approved?

If you have any questions please contact your regional Inspector General. **After making your inspections, please read the statement below, sign it, and return this sheet to the NWT Adjutant before December 1st. Failure to turn it in by the deadline costs your unit \$25.** Your attention to detail now will eliminate problems during a skirmish inspection. Thank you for your time and effort.
