ALL UNITS entering teams are required to submit the Team Registration form so that the host units can plan accordingly.

Camping opens at 12 noon on Friday, June 13th. There are approximately 20 electrical hookups available, but they are not adequate to run AC. A \$15 fee will be collected per hookup. Ground fires are permitted as long as extremely dry conditions don't present a safety hazard. Please fill in fire pits before you leave. Skirmishers are asked to bring their own water and please take your trash home for disposal. The onsite dumpster is for target disposal and other range waste.

The Lansing Muzzleloaders will be providing food service for the weekend. Breakfast and lunch will be served on Saturday and Sunday.

All N-SSA rules will be in effect throughout the weekend. Individual events will be classified per NWT classifications, with places paid accordingly.

Please return unbroken targeting to the ready area in containers that will be provided.

MAKE SURE TO PICK UP ALL WIRES and keep an eye out & pick up any wires found anywhere to help save on mower damage.

DIRECTIONS TO:LANSING MUZZLELOADING GUN CLUB LAINGSBURG, MICHIGAN

FROM THE DETROIT AREA...

Take I-96 west to M-52 north toward Owosso. Approximately 7 miles north of Perry, turn left (west) on Bennington Road. Take Bennington approximately 5-1/2 miles to Leland Road. Go south on Leland for about 2/3 mile. Just as Leland sweeps to the right, take a hard left on Garrison Road (gravel road). The entrance to the gun club is about 1/8 mile on the right.

FROM THE FLINT AREA...

Take I-69 south to Exit 105 (Perry). From Perry, head north on M-52 toward Owosso. Approximately 7 miles north of Perry, turn left (west) on Bennington Road. Take Bennington approximately 5-1/2 miles to Leland Road. Go south on Leland for about 2/3 mile. Just as Leland sweeps to the right, take a hard left on Garrison Road (gravel road). The entrance to the gun club is about 1/8 mile on the right.

FROM THE NORTH...

Take Route 27 south, past St. Johns to Price Road. Follow Price Road east toward Sleepy Hollow State Park. At the county line, Price Road becomes Garrison Road and turns to gravel. When the gravel road ends, continue east for approximately 1/8 mile on Leland Road (paved road). Just as Leland starts to sweep to the left, go straight on the gravel road (which is Garrison Road once again). The entrance to the gun club is about 1/8 mile on the right.

FROM THE WEST...

Take I-96 east to I-69 north to Exit 98 (Laingsburg). Head north on Woodbury Road for approximately 1-1/2 miles until you come to the intersection of Bath Road. Turn right on Bath, go about 1/8 mile and turn left on Woodbury Road again. Follow Woodbury approximately 4-1/2 miles until you come to a 4-way stop. Go straight through the 4-way stop and continue for about 1/2 mile until Woodbury ends. Turn right and then immediately left on Leland Road, following it north. Leland will make a big sweeping curve to the right and then a big sweeping curve to the left. Just as Leland sweeps left, go straight on Garrison Road (gravel road). The entrance to the gun club is about 1/8 mile on the right.

FROM THE SOUTHWEST...

Take I-69 north to Exit 98 (Laingsburg). Head north on Woodbury Road for approximately 1-1/2 miles until you come to the intersection of Bath Road. Turn right on Bath, go approximately 1/8 mile and turn left on Woodbury Road again. Follow Woodbury approximately 4-1/2 miles until you come to a 4-way stop. Go straight through the 4-way stop and continue for about 1/2 mile until Woodbury ends. Turn right and then immediately left on Leland Road, following it north. Leland will make a big sweeping curve to the right and then a big sweeping curve to the left. Just as Leland sweeps left, go straight on Garrison Road (gravel road). FROM THE SOUTH...

Take Hwy 127 north toward Jackson. Northeast of Jackson, Hwy 127 runs concurrent with I-94 for approximately 4 miles. Follow 127/I-94 until it becomes Hwy 127 north again. Take 127 north to I-69 north to Exit 98 (Laingsburg). Head north on Woodbury Road for approximately 1-1/2 miles until you come to the intersection of Bath Road. Turn right on Bath, go approximately 1/8 mile and turn left on Woodbury Road again. Follow Woodbury approximately 4-1/2 miles until you come to a 4-way stop. Go straight through the 4-way stop and continue for about 1/2 mile until Woodbury ends. Turn right and then immediately left on Leland Road, following it north. Leland will make a big sweeping curve to the right and then a big sweeping curve to the left. Just as Leland sweeps left, go straight on Garrison Road (gravel road).
